## COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD NOMINATION FORM

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Thank you for your interest and input in the proposed development of 575 Fifth Avenue and its associated Community Advisory Board (575 CAB). The role of the Community Advisory Board is to provide on-going input into the proposed affordable, supportive housing development at 575 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and help to foster a positive working relationship between Fifth Avenue Committee (FAC), the on-site social service partner Center for Urban Community Services (CUCS), local community residents and business owners, and the building's future residents.

We anticipate that 575 CAB will focus on the following areas:

- *Resident Screening* to assist in screening of prospective residents;
- *Retail Outreach* to recruit local, women and minority owned businesses and give input into retail tenant selection;
- *Community Outreach* to encourage local eligible residents to apply, to continue to share information about the project on an on-going basis, and to promote the use of community spaces in the building;
- *Construction* to assist in minimizing the disruption to the local community as a result of the construction.

At this time, FAC is accepting nominations for representation on the 575 CAB and we will be honoring Community Board 7's recommendation to include six (6) local residents, business representatives and a CB7 member on the 575 CAB. Additional nominations will be accepted from community residents, and local social service and civic organizations. Fifth Avenue Committee and Center for Urban Community Service staff will also be on the 575 CAB.

**Please return the form found on the reverse side of this letter by May 15, 2007 to be considered for nomination.** We anticipate the time commitment to be one to two weekday evening(s) for approximately two hours per month for the first 12-16 months of operation. Just prior to the building's completion, the time commitment will be greater and may be during business hours, especially for the Resident Screening committee.

All who live or who own a business in close proximity to 575 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue are encouraged to apply. A preference will be given to:

- Residents who live within two blocks of the intersection of 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 16<sup>th</sup> Street,
- Business owners or representatives on Fifth Avenue near the site
- Representatives of service organizations, particularly those in Community Board 7
